Assessment in PSHE Education (Primary phase)

In order to become successful learners within PSHE education topics, pupils need regular opportunities to reflect and identify what they have learned and what they need to learn next. To enable this to happen, assessment needs to become an integral part of the process for both pupils and teachers alike.

Although assessment within PSHEe is often less straight forward than in other subjects, it is possible to use a range of effective methods within lessons that not only recognise and evidence progress and attainment in knowledge, skills and understanding, but also improve the learning experience too.

The session will examine the thinking behind assessment within PSHE education and how teachers can integrate effective methods into their practice.

- Explore a range of practical strategies to include within their own PSHE curriculum provision
- More confidently assess and evaluate effective PSHE education within the primary phase
