Ofsted & PSHE education: Making the links

This course aims to give delegates a clear and practical picture of how high quality Personal, Social, Health and Economic education (PSHEe) can make a significant contribution to successful Ofsted judgements.

A well - established PSHEe curriculum can provide valuable opportunities for schools to evidence practise within Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare (PDBW) and Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural (SMSC) development (including Fundamental British Values). It can also demonstrate a proactive approach to safeguarding responsibilities.

Research also suggests that schools judged to be 'outstanding' by Ofsted are more likely to have outstanding PSHE education programmes.

This session will:

- Assist colleagues in making clear and meaningful links between PSHEe and the current Ofsted framework
- Show how effective PSHEe provision can enhance evidence for Ofsted inspections and provide valuable opportunities to discharge other duties
- Help schools to ensure that their PSHEe provision is 'ready for inspection'
