Re: Consultation on the Proposed Expansion of Pupil Numbers at Perry Hall Primary School

I am writing to inform you of a proposal to expand pupil numbers at Perry Hall Primary School and to formally commence a period of consultation regarding this development.

Levels of demand for in-year primary school places in Wolverhampton have increased significantly in recent years. This is due to a combination of factors including increased migration, local regeneration and housing developments, and the continued popularity and strong OFSTED ratings of Wolverhampton schools. Perry Hall Primary School, which was recently judged by OFSTED to be *Good* with *Outstanding* features, is highly sought-after by local families.

As a result, the City of Wolverhampton Council has approached Perry Hall Primary School and Perry Hall Multi-Academy Trust to support in meeting this growing demand for school places in the area.

The Proposal

We propose to expand Perry Hall Primary School's physical and pupil capacity from 420 to 480 pupils. This includes the addition of 30 places in Year 3 and 30 places in Year 5, with effect from September 2025.

Rationale for Expansion

- To meet the increasing demand for primary school places in the local area.
- To ensure that more local children can access high-quality education within a reasonable distance of their home.



- To undertake a *significant change* as defined under the Academy Trust Handbook and DfE guidance, ensuring full compliance with all regulations.
- To invest in the school's infrastructure to support sustainable growth in pupil numbers.

What Will the Provision Look Like?

- **Staffing:** Each new class will be led by a fully qualified teacher and supported by appropriate support staff where required.
- **Curriculum:** The new classes will follow the National Curriculum, in line with existing provision, ensuring a consistent, high-quality learning experience for all pupils.
- **Accommodation:** The school will undergo internal remodelling to create two new classrooms. Extensions to the existing building will also be undertaken to replace areas repurposed for teaching, and to provide additional group rooms and learning spaces to support the larger school community.

Consultation Process

The consultation will run from 9th June to 30th June.
